**About** Combining my two loves of playing the cello and teaching, I draw on my 10+ years of experience as a cellist and educator to offer lessons that are structured and systematic, while also leaving room for us to find inspiration along the way. For high school and adult students we will discuss your goals and go at a pace that feels right for you. For all ages and levels, my goal is that through listening and learning by heart, I can help you explore the character and beauty of each piece and give you the foundation of technique to find joy and satisfaction in making music.
